Spring 1957 Region 12 Competition in Berkeley, California - Directed by Bob Hokanson. Placed 1st with 25 on stage. Costume: red/white striped vest, white blouse, red skirt. Songs: *April Showers (?) & Alice Blue Gown*

Spring 1959 Region 12 Competition in Oakland, California - Directed by Bob Hokanson. Placed 1st with 27 on stage. Costume: light blue dance length dress, red flower. Songs: *Hello My Baby & Roses of Picardy*

April 29, 1961 Region 12 Competition in San Francisco, California - Directed by Jerry Lynch. Placed 3rd with 31 on stage. Costume: dance length dress, blue & white satin. Songs: *Roses of Picardy & ?*
